Caritas Pakistan, part of the international
 confederation of Catholic relief, development
 and social service organizations, is setting up
 medical relief camps in the stricken areas to
 provide health care for at least three to four
 days.

Unofficial reports from the Saturday quake that
 struck Pakistan, India, and Afghanistan put the
 death toll in Pakistan at about 30,000, while the
 number of injured approaches 60,000.
 Caritas Pakistan's executive secretary, Anila Gil,
 reported that many Caritas member
 organisations have expressed solidarity and
 offered assistance, including 700 winter tents,
 4,200 blankets, and resources for the purchase
 of essential food and non-food items.
