altered to include couples of the same sex. When Federal Parliament resumes this month, marriage will be up for debate, with the Greens now having secured parliamentary time for members to report back to Parliament on their consultations. You will recall that in December 2010 our parish presented many signed petition sheets in defence of the natural, traditional and Christian understanding of Marriage to out local Federal Member.
