CHURCH WELCOMES NEW MEMBERS (ZENIT NEWS)

This Easter, 3,500 adult catechumens in Hong Kong were received into the Catholic Church. Cardinal John Tong of Hong Kong thanked those who had helped prepare them, Asia News reported. The Diocese of Hong Kong has 39 paid catechists and more than 1,500 voluntary catechists, according to statistics published last August. The Catholic population of Hong Kong is made up of 363,000 Chinese and 138,000 non-Chinese.

Meanwhile, in England and Wales 3,695 adults were received into the Catholic Church at Easter. The largest group was in the Diocese of Westminster, with 734, followed by Southwark, with 481.
